Dear Senators and Representatives:

As members and leaders of the faith community, we encourage you, our elected leaders, to take steps during the upcoming Special Session that will protect the lives and safety of our children. As you may know, **gun violence is the No. 1 killer of kids and teenagers** in Tennessee and across our nation. Moreover, **59% of these gun deaths are self-inflicted wounds**.

We join together to support a pragmatic, evidence-based response to firearms injury and death, <u>as proposed in the opinion piece authored by Senator-Doctor Bill Frist, Rev. Clay Stauffer, and Dr. Alex</u> Jahangir.

We support Governor Lee's investment in school safety and funding, and ask legislators to also take these further steps:

1. Allow authorities to temporarily remove guns from those who pose a risk to themselves or others by enacting **Extreme Risk Protection Orders**.

Adopted by 21 states across the political spectrum, these laws have shown <u>early evidence</u> of reducing suicide deaths, and give concerned families and law enforcement a tool to use when someone poses a credible threat but has yet to commit a crime. When used effectively, these laws allow for temporarily confiscating the firearms of potentially dangerous people or barring them from purchasing firearms.

2. Keep guns away from dangerous people by **expanding background checks on all firearms** *purchases*.

<u>Data</u> indicate that those legally prohibited from purchasing weapons circumvent the system by obtaining firearms through private sales. Tennessee and other states should close this loophole, as fourteen other states have done.

3. Stop firearms from falling into the wrong hands by **implementing child access prevention** *and safe storage laws*.

Both types of laws promote safe and responsible gun ownership. Child-access prevention laws impose penalties on adults who allow children unsupervised access to firearms, while safe storage laws require gun owners to store firearms unloaded and in locked containers and/or disabled with trigger locks.

## 4. Require firearms safety courses for ownership.

Every licensed hunter in Tennessee must complete a hunter education course. If we know this type of education reduces firearms injuries and accidental deaths, why not apply an education and training requirement to firearm ownership? In addition to improving safety, it could also weed out individuals who only plan to use firearms for nefarious purposes or who are mentally unwell.

As members and leaders in the faith community, we stand with and represent the vast majority of Tennesseans who support responsible, sensible gun laws, like the ones we list above.

In our grief after The Covenant School shooting, we are doing the work of mourning. We stand together for responsible, sensible measures, alongside our rights, to create sustainable gun laws that will demonstrate that we value, cherish, and choose to protect our children and teens—now and in the years to come.

We ask for your leadership to save lives.
